NOTE: Through the September 2017 testing window, the CP examination consisted of five separate sections. Candidates were not required to take all five sections during the same testing window. All sections were required to be completed within a two-year application period.

Effective with the 2018 CP examination structure, the exam consists of the Knowledge Exam administered year-round, and Skills Exam administered during the months of February, April, July, and October. All candidates must take and pass the Knowledge Exam before receiving authorization to take the Skills Exam.
